Before buying feed: Keep your animal on a consistent ration whenever possible. Sudden feed changes can cause digestive trouble, especially in horses and livestock. Ask your veterinarian, Extension agent, or feed specialist before making a major change.

Mammoth Cave Backcountry Horse Trails Address: Mammoth Cave National Park - north of the Green River Phone: Check current park conditions before traveling Approximately 60 miles of backcountry trails are open to horseback riding, with wooded terrain, creeks, ridges, and scenic areas. Review trail rules, parking, weather, and river-access conditions before hauling in.	

Horse Emergency Planning Checklist

1	Save your veterinarian's regular and after-hours numbers.
2	Keep trailer, tow vehicle, and loading equipment ready.
3	Post the farm address clearly for emergency responders.
4	Maintain a basic first-aid kit and current medication list.
5	Know where you can isolate a sick or injured horse.
6	Keep vaccination, Coggins, farrier, and insurance records together.
